
Connecting a roger toughscreen to a Laptop

1. Turn Touchscreen On

Press and hold on/off button for at least 3 seconds until you get a green flashing light.



2. Connect Touchscreen to your Hearing Aid Receiver / Neckloop




3. Connect to Touchscreen

 a) Connect 3.5mm audio cable to the round audio jack at the bottom of the Touchscreen.





b) The Audio Setting Screen will appear automatically. Ensure that "Input" is selected on Touchscreen





4. Plug In to Device

Plus in the other end of the cable to the headphone audio jack on your laptop





5. Select "OK" (if required)

Ensure headset. Is selected

(This may differ depending on your device and system set up.)
