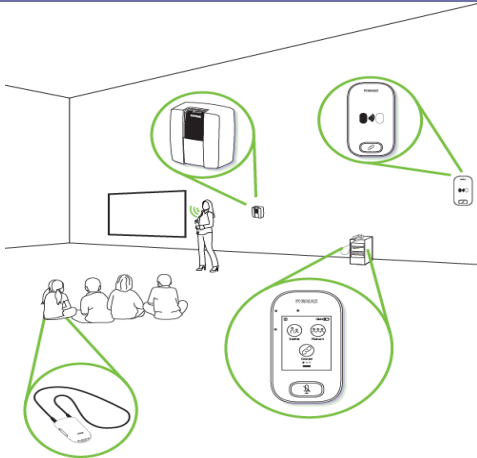


PA / LARGE ROOM SOLUTION



Roger Touchscreen Microphone

This easy to use microphone transmits the speaker's voice and audio feeds, whilst reducing background noise. The audio can be transmitted to the Soundfield speakers, directly to Roger receivers in hearing aids or to other portable Roger receivers such as the Roger Neckloop which links to telecoil enabled hearing aids.



- 3 intuitive directional microphones,
- 3.5mm audio input,
- Secure & private system,
- 2.4Ghz wireless transmission,
- 20 meter range.

Roger Wall Pilot

This wall-mounted device automatically connects Roger Receivers & Neckloops to the room's existing hearing augmentation network.



Roger Neckloop

An easy to use personal receiver, suitable for use with any hearing aid featuring an enabled telecoil.

- Light weight & discrete (can be worn under clothing)
- 10 hrs battery life (comes with USB charger)
- Min 2 per venue (D3.7 requires 1 per 25 adults)



Additional Options: Speakers, Repeater, Pass-around Microphones, Additional Wall Pilots, Additional Neckloops, Neckloop Charging Rack

Hearing Augmentation Package

Roger devices provide increased clarity of speech to people who are hard of hearing, via a Roger Receiver or their telecoil enabled hearing aid using a Roger Neckloop.

This portable, flexible solution can be used as a stand alone augmentation device or connected to the PA system thus providing a more comprehensive solution.

Package includes:

- 1 x Roger Touchscreen Microphone or Base Station
- 1 x Roger Wall Pilot
- 1 x Braille Hearing Augmentation Sign
- ** Roger Repeater may be required

Large Area Soundfield Package

Combining Roger Microphones, Soundfield Speakers with other devices improves clarity of sound for all participants with seamless connectivity in rooms over 120m².

Package includes:

- 2 x Wall Mounted DigiMaster 7000 Soundfield Speakers
- 1 x Roger Touchscreen Microphone
- 1 x Roger Wall Pilot
- 1 x Braille Hearing Augmentation Sign

In addition, every facility may be required to have a minimum of 2 Roger Neckloops to enable connection for adults. Most children do not need to be supplied neckloops as they are provided with Roger Receivers by Hearing Australia or NDIS. Additional Roger Neckloops may be required for building code compliance depending on capacity. If unsure, please speak to one of our team members.
