
HOW TO USE ROGERTM RECEIVER

Your hearing system consists of three main elements: Roger MyLink, your hearing aids and a Roger transmitter, such as Roger Touchscreen or Roger Media Hub. The Roger microphone transmits the audio or speaker's voice wirelessly to your hearing aids via the Roger MyLink. You only need to activate the T-Coil in your hearing aid (s) to hear the speaker's voice loud and clear in your ear(s).

Roger MyLink (02) - Use with T-Switch / Telecoil



- 1. Charging Socket
- 2. 2.5mm Headphone



- For hearing devices fitted with telecoil put neck loop around your neck. It can be tucked underneath clothing.
- 2. Switch receiver MyLink **ON** with the Green side visible.
- 3. Switch hearing device to "telecoil" mode.
- 4. Adjust loudness on Roger™ receiver & hearing devices to desired volume.
 - 1 Volume control
 - 2 On/off



Roger MyLink (02) - Use with Headphones

- 1. For hearing devices fitted with telecoil put neck loop around your neck.
- 2. Switch MyLink receiver ON.
